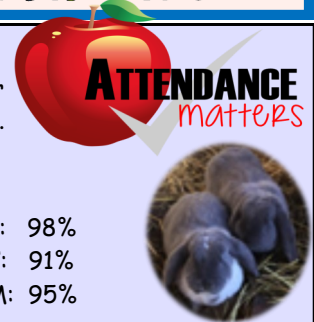

Little Litter Heroes

I am writing to let you know about a new campaign I am launching called Little Litter Heroes that I would love for your school to get involved with.

In connection with Keep Britain Tidy I am hoping to get as many schools as possible on board, with the aim of inspiring the next generation about environmental issues.

The statistics around litter and plastic pollution are staggering. Keep Britain Tidy estimate that there are nearly 3 billion cans that are not recycled every year, and that some 3 million small mammals – mostly shrews and voles – die as a result of this.

I am keen for our area and especially children in local schools to be part of the solution.

There are two categories that children can participate in:

- Get creative:** design a poster, or bring in your used clean recycling and see what you can design and make.
- Get writing:** put pen to (recycled!) paper and write about your ideas for projects and steps we can all take to tackle litter and promote pride in our towns.

There will be prizes awarded in each of the categories and it would be wonderful to attend in person to thank the winners.

Medicines - Medicine prescribed **ONLY** by a doctor is permitted in school. It **MUST** be brought to the school office, on arrival at school - and will only be administered to the child by the Headteacher / Deputy Head or Assistant Head, as in line with our school's 'Medical Needs Policy'.

A 'Parental & School Agreement to Store Medication for Administration' must be completed by the parent / guardian, when leaving medicine in school. A 'Record of Medicine Administered to an Individual Child' will be used to record dosages administered to the child.
