#### The Children's Recreational Fund

As you know, St. Paulinus' is a voluntary aided Catholic school.

We would like to take this opportunity to say "Thank you" to the 16% who have contributed to 'The Children's Recreational Fund' through ParentPay. To say 'thank you' your child will have received a Thank You card this week.

Whatever your contribution, this is greatly appreciated. Our school is responsible for funding 10% of all external repairs and improvements. The Governors offer a guide of £19.50 per child / £38.00 per family, which can be paid through your ParentPay account. This can be broken down into smaller payments and paid monthly.

Over recent years 'The Children's Recreational Fund' has paid for KS1 playground, Noah's Ark farm, fire alarm, works on KS1 toilets and roofing works.




#### Shoe Box Appeal 2018
