Places are limited to 16 children on a first come first served basis.

Children will be required to wear P.E. kit, and all jewellery **must** be removed for safety. Please supply your child with a bottle of water.

If you would like your child to take part in this after school event please complete the application form titled 'Years 4 - 6 Cricket Club (After School)' by accessing the School App, select 'More' then 'Forms'.

The App can be downloaded by searching for 'St. Paulinus Catholic Primary School' in your Apple / Play store.

Please ensure this is completed on the App no later than Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> June. You will be notified by Groupcall, the following week if your child has secured a place.

Due to safety, when collecting your child from any of our After School Clubs, can I remind you of the following:

- Please wait **outside** the main reception entrance, where the group will be escorted down to reception and the door will be opened to allow you to collect them ensuring their safety at all times.
- You should not go to your child's classroom or cloakroom **for any reason**. If they have forgotten **essential** belongings (eg. coat or shoes), please speak to a member of staff. You will not be allowed to go searching for non-essential items such as reading books or homework.
