Yrs 1 - 6 Health & Fitness Week

We will be holding our Health & Fitness week from Monday 8th – Friday 12th July. The children will experience and take part in a range of different sports by specialist coaches. They will learn about having a healthy lifestyle and why being fit and healthy is so important.

For this week only, the children can come to school for the whole week wearing P.E. kit, if not then they must wear their school uniform. A P.E. kit consists of: a white t-shirt, blue (or black) shorts, and a pair of sports trainers for outdoor use, which they should leave in school. As an optional extra, a dark coloured pair of jogging trousers and a jumper can also be worn when we are outside, if it is cold.

If your child has pierced ears, it would be much appreciated if you could remove their earrings this week. We are **NOT** able to remove them or cover them, due to health and safety reasons. Long hair must be tied back.
