



Letters and Sounds / Phonics, Phase 4

Your child is currently working at Phase 4 in their phonics.



Purpose

When children start Phase 4 of the Letter and Sounds phonics programme, they will know a grapheme for each of the 42 phonemes. They will be able to blend phonemes to read CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant, e.g. dog) words and segment in order to spell them.

Children will also have begun reading straight forward two-syllable words (rocket) and simple captions (the big dog), as well as reading and spelling some tricky words (you, me, her, are)

Letter Progression

In Phase 4, no new graphemes are introduced. The main aim of this phase is to consolidate the children's knowledge and to help them learn to read and spell words which have adjacent consonants, such as trap, string and milk.

During Phase 4, the following tricky words (which can't yet be decoded) are introduced: said, have, like, so, do, some, come, where, there, little, one, when, out, what.

Reading Captions

- ⇒ Her best painting was the window.
- ⇒ Mum swam across the deep pond.
- ⇒ He had never slept in a bunk.
- \Rightarrow She has to stick stamps on his letters.
- ⇒ Is the moon a lump of green cheese?
- ⇒ Are clowns funny when they do tricks?
- ⇒ Is fresh crab good with sweet custard?

Letters and Sounds / Phonics, Phase 4

Pseudo / nonsense words

In Year 1 your child will complete a national test reading a mixture of Pseudo / nonsense words and real words. The phonics screening check is a short, simple assessment to make sure that all pupils have learned phonic decoding to an appropriate standard by the age of 6.
