

School Uniform Reminder/ Update

September 2021 – July 2022

Everything can be purchased from Rawcliffes and our second hand uniform shop

Normal Day Uniform:

- School jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Pale blue polo shirt (with or without logo)
- Grey trousers / knee length shorts for Summer
- Skirts or pinafore dresses can be worn if they prefer / blue & white checked dress (Summer)
- Grey or white socks / grey tights
- Sensible **all black** shoes – no boots, sandals or heels *

* *Children run about a lot at playtimes and we need to wear sensible footwear that allows for this*



P.E. Day Uniform:

- Grey School Hoodie with the school logo
- Plain white t-shirt – no brands or patterns (these can also be purchased with school logo which helps us look smart when we go to competitions, if you wish)
- Plain black or dark grey jogging bottoms / leggings or shorts (no brands or patterns)
- Trainers



Please make sure your child does not wear tights on this day; for safety reasons they will need to remove them if they are using the dance studio or doing gymnastics

Jewellery:

This should not be worn in school and no jewellery whatsoever is allowed to be worn for P.E. / swimming. If you allow your child to have their ears pierced, do so at the beginning of the summer holidays, as they will not be allowed to do P.E. for 6 weeks following the piercing. Small studs are allowed but these **must** be left at home on P.E. days.

Hair:

Highlights, strong patterns, dyed designs or sculptured patterns / shaved lines are **not** allowed in school. Please can you be vigilant when the time comes for a new haircut; keep it minimalist. You can save these treats for the Summer holiday and for when they are at high school!
