I hope you all have an amazing bank holiday weekend and I will see you all on Tuesday!!

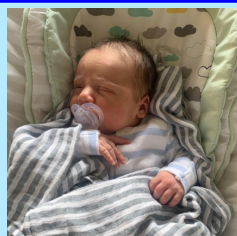

3rd Sunday of Easter

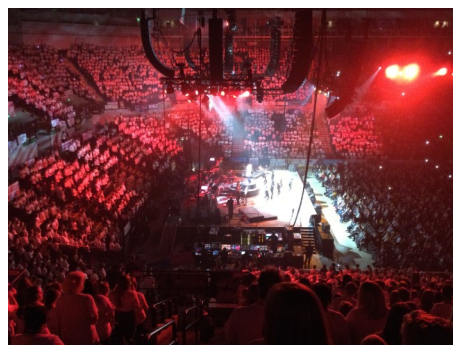

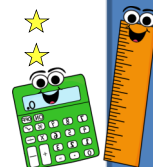
