


As a school we consider attendance to be extremely important and would like the continued support of our parents in ensuring their child attends school regularly and on time. We have a zero tolerance policy on parents taking their children out of school to go on holiday. Kirklees Council will issue penalty notices or it may lead to fast track prosecution at the magistrate's court, if you are convicted, you could be fined up to £1000 and you will get a criminal record, this is regardless of your child's attendance percentage.

It is not a Food Bank but a scheme of which individuals pay £7.50 and receive £35.00 of food in return, it's to support natural food wastage and also affordable living. The scheme has been run successfully from Chickenley Community Centre.

What they need to make this a possibility is volunteers with a strong interest in making Dewsbury Moor a better place and those that want to support our local community: they are seeking a group of approximately 14 volunteers, knowing that they can run the scheme off 8 volunteers, training will be provided by the organisation TBBT so don't be alarmed if worried about not being able to do it, as there is support throughout.

The commitment would be 1 afternoon approximately 12:00 until 16:00 hours every Tuesday.

Attendance Absence



If your child is absent from school you MUST telephone the office on (01924 488282) on the first day of absence before 09:30 am and provide a reason.

If we receive no confirmation of the reason you will receive a phone call home. If we are unable to get hold of you within 45 mins of school registers being taken we will contact the next person your child's emergency list. If we are unable if we are unable to get hold of anyone we may arrange a home visit.


