Dear Parents / Carers

Sunday 27th November 2022 marks the first day of Advent and for us in school it is the start of preparations for Christmas. Below you will find all the information you need about different things we do at Christmas time and how they will be a little bit different this year.

Prepare for Advent day – Non-uniform! Friday 25th November 2022

We will be hosting our annual prepare for advent day on Friday. We ask that the children come in non-uniform and that they bring a chocolate donation (e.g. selection box or bar of chocolate) instead of the customary money donation. The children will spend their day getting ready for Advent, e.g. making their advent promises, learning Christmas carols, decorating their classroom etc. It is a really fun day!



Coppers for CAFOD – from Monday 28th November 2022

Don't forget to donate your coppers for CAFOD. Last year we managed to buy all sorts of things for families living in poverty to support themselves e.g. buying queen bees so they could make honey or chickens for eggs. We also bought things to help them get water and mosquito nets to keep them safe at night. I wonder what we will buy this year!



The children can bring in their coppers (or larger denominations if you would prefer) at any point between Monday 28th November and Friday 9th December. As the common phrase goes, every little counts! Coppers may not hold much value on their own but once combined they can really change someone's life through this scheme.

As per tradition, we will be closing school slightly earlier for the end of Autumn Term on Friday 16th December as follows :


Nursery : 11:45 | Reception / Years 1 – 6 : 13:15
