

The children will spend the day doing fun and inspiring activities to develop their love of reading.

Dressing up is a big part of World Book Day and this year will be no exception. Considering the current cost-of-living crisis it seems sensible to find a way that all families can take part for minimum cost.

Last year, we made a slight change to the dressing up theme and asked children to dress up as their favourite word. We received positive feedback from families and as a result we have decided to do the same again this year.
