This week, we introduced a new program (in our whole school assembly) to all year groups from EYU to Year 6 called 'My Happy Mind'.





My Happy Mind is all based around helping children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves! It is delivered in schools by class teachers every Monday through a series of interactive lessons (Lesson 1 – Meet you Brain starts next week) and then the children apply these learnings throughout the day recording their ideas in their very own 'My Happy Mind' journal.

To further embed this learning, My Happy Mind has developed a Parent App. These resources can be accessed online on your computer, or through an app on your phone. The Parent App will support you as a parent in understanding what your child is learning, activities for you to do together at home and also a Kids Zone featuring My Happy Mind Games plus much more!
